

# QUICK START GUIDE FOR WINDOWS - GU Express

## Registering an Account

1

Open your Internet Browser.



Go to  
<http://www.graphicsunlimited.com.au>  
to Register.

2

Click PDF Express  
then click Register

Enter your Account details.

Fields marked with an asterisk (\*) are compulsory required fields.

When all required fields have been entered, click Submit.



3

Email Notification



A confirmation email, containing your username and password details, will be emailed to the email address you supplied on the registration form.

Click on the provided link in the email to go to the login page.

Login Process



Enter your user name and password into the corresponding fields and click Login.

A new User Profile menu will appear on the site to let you know that you are logged in.

Registration Complete

Click on the Download link in the User Profile menu.

Click on the Download button that corresponds to your Operating System to download the software.

**\*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\* Close all applications.**

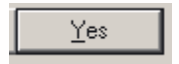
Double Click the Installer (.exe)
